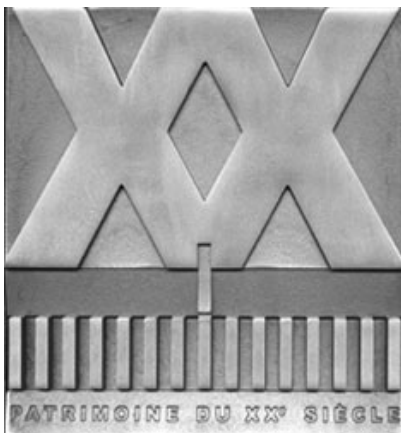


- Since the gardens first opened to the public in 1996, Les Jardins de l'Imaginaire has received two national awards.



In the spring of 2004, the Minister of Culture awarded them with the **label "Remarkable Garden"**.

This award is granted to gardens open to the public that have a cultural, aesthetic, historic or botanical interest. This label goes beyond the scope of traditional gardens which may or may not be listed among the historical monuments. The criteria taken into account for its attribution are: garden composition, the integration of the garden into its environment. Les Jardins de l'Imaginaire is one of 13 gardens having this label in the Aquitaine region and 324 in France.



In 2007, the gardens also received the label created in 1999 by the Minister of Culture and Communication, **"20th Century Heritage"**

This label indicates the remarkable buildings and urban features of the last century's achievements. Les Jardins de l'Imaginaire is one of the 36 sites with this label in the Aquitaine region, and were
